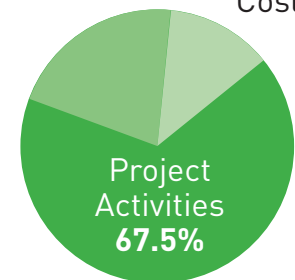

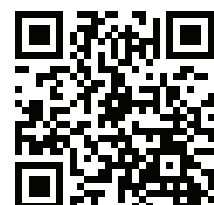

Worked with Jesuit Worldwide Learning to deliver a competitive English course to pursue English related careers.

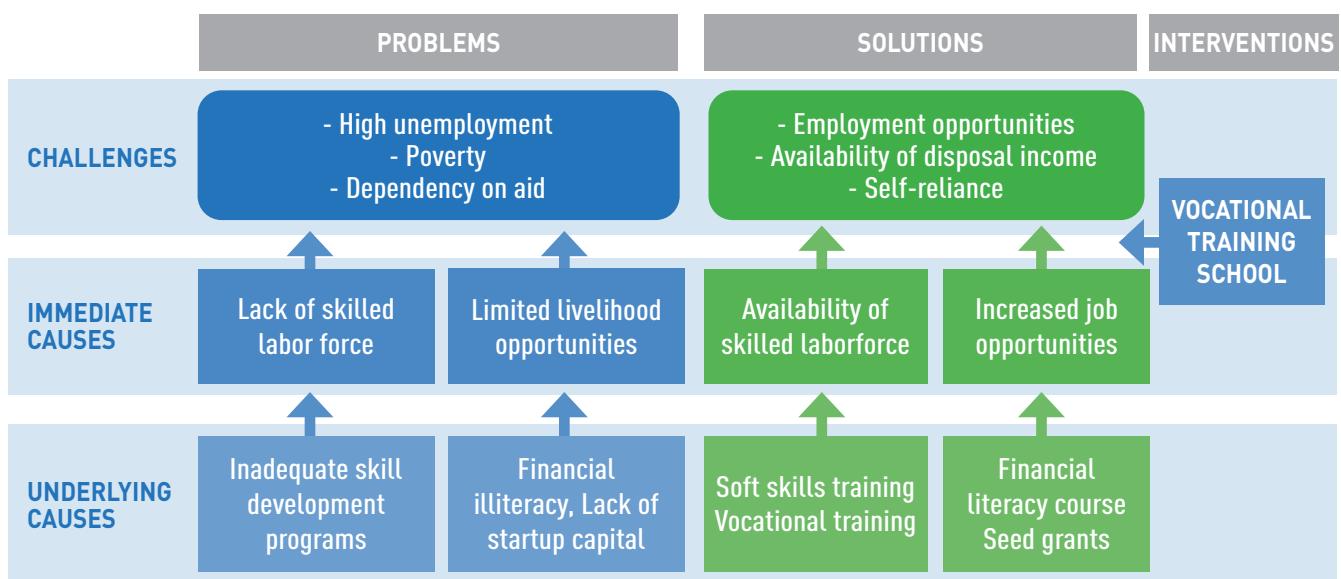


Digital Literacy Program
